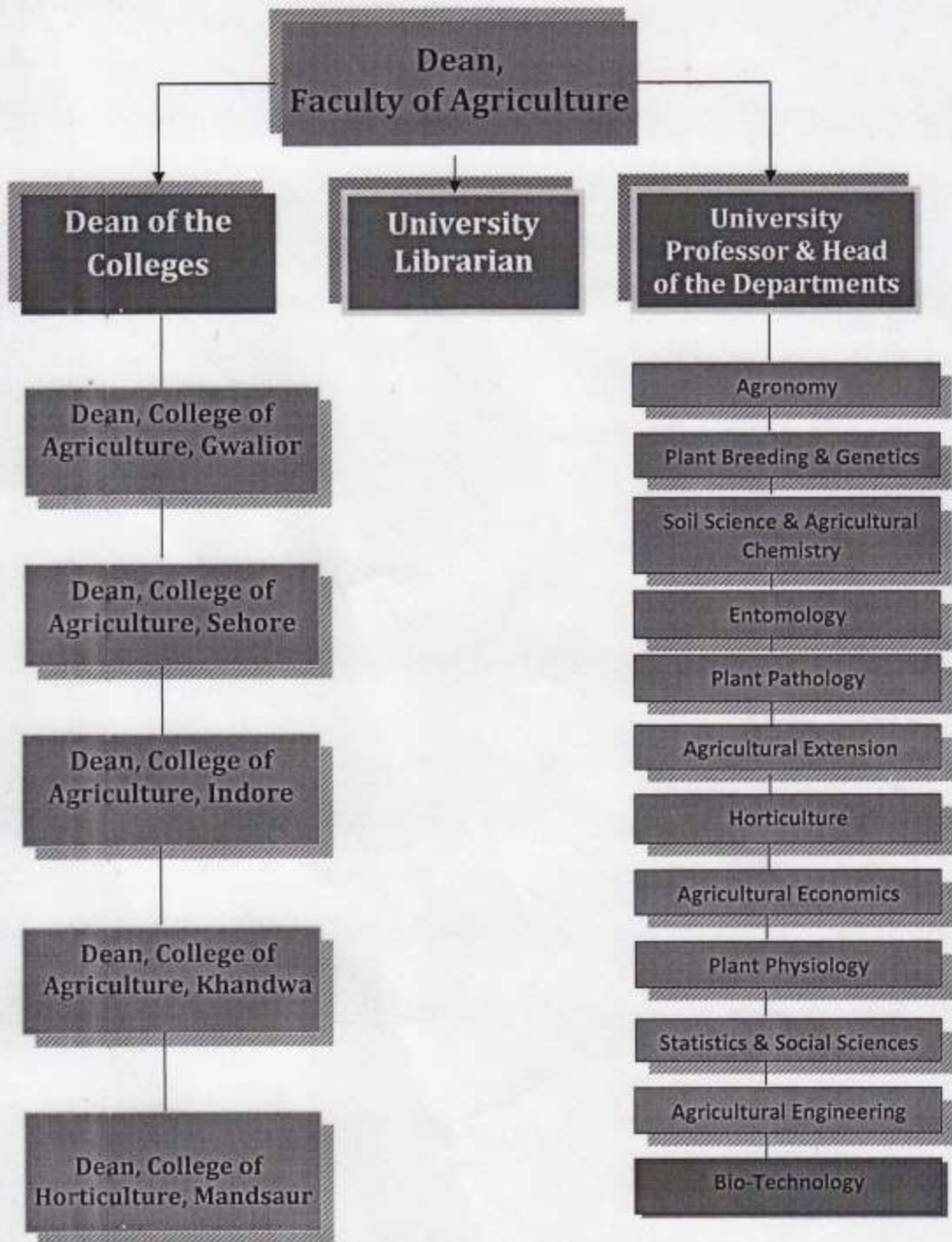

### **Agricultural Education:**

The Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwavidyalaya, Gwalior was established by Government of Madhya Pradesh Vide Ordinance No. 4 of 2008 notified in the Extraordinary Gazette No. 507 dated 19<sup>th</sup> August 2008 as second Agricultural University by bifurcating the JNKVV, Jabalpur.

University has been the seat of Agro-Horti Technology and Human Resource Development in Central India. Its mission is to impart education in agriculture and its allied sciences so as to provide human resource for meeting the future challenges.

## PROFILE OF THE CONSTITUENT COLLEGES

### 1. College of Agriculture, Gwalior:



This is the oldest college of the state of Madhya Pradesh and established in 1950 with the affiliation to Agra University and then with Vikram University, Ujjain. In the year 1964, after establishment of Jawaharlal Nehru Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur, this College was one of Constituents colleges of JNKVV, Jabalpur. On 19<sup>th</sup> August 2008 a new Agricultural University- Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya was established by bifurcation of JNKVV,

Jabalpur with head quarter at Gwalior and this college compose came under the jurisdiction of Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya. This college is located at Gird region of Madhya Pradesh. Dean is the Chief Executive of the College. He is supported by heads of the various Departments. Since its establishment, the college has created a base for teaching, research and extension in Agriculture.

## 2. College of Agriculture, Sehore:



The foundation of College of Agriculture, Sehore was laid down by the first Food and Agriculture Minister of India, Late Shri Rafi Ahmad Kidwai on 01<sup>st</sup> August, 1952. This college originally named as Agriculture Institute was established. At that time, this college was up to intermediate level and the college was affiliated with the Agra University, Agra. On 17<sup>th</sup> July, 1955, Union Minister for Food and Agriculture, Shri Ajit Prasad Jain laid foundation of Rafi Amhad Kidwai Undergraduate College and

Agricultural Research Institute and the college was affiliated with Vikaram University, Ujjain. In the year 1964, after establishment of Jawaharlal Nehru Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur, this college was one of the constituent colleges of JNKVV, Jabalpur. On 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2008 a new agricultural university- Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya was established by the bifurcation of JNKVV with head quarter at Gwalior and this college is under administrative control of RVSKVV, Gwalior. This college is situated in semi urban area of Sehore town, 40 Km away from the state capital Bhopal and 150 Km away from Indore.

#### 4. College of Agriculture, Khandwa:



The College of Agriculture Khandwa was established in the name of the former Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Shri Bhagavant Rao Mandloi in 1986. The college is located in the Nimar Valley of Madhya Pradesh. The climate of this region is hot and dry with an average annual rainfall of about 800 mm which is unevenly distributed. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Sh. Motilal Vora laid down the foundation stone of B.M. College of Agriculture, Khandwa under the jurisdiction of the J.N.K.V.V.

Jabalpur. The college came under jurisdiction of R.V.S.K.V.V. Gwalior on 19.08.2008. There are 12 departments working in this college: Agronomy, Plant Physiology, Agricultural Statistics Computer Science, Agricultural Economics & Farm Management, Extension Education Rural Sociology, Entomology, Food Science Technology, Plant Breeding Genetics, Plant Pathology, Soil Science Agricultural Chemistry, Horticulture and Agricultural Engineering.

## 5. College of Horticulture, Mandsaur:



College of Horticulture, Mandsaur was established on March 28, 1987 as the College of Agriculture. Later on the College of Agriculture was converted into the College of Horticulture on October 4, 2002. This is the only College of Horticulture in Madhya Pradesh. The first B.Sc. (Hort.) batch was admitted in the College in the year 2002. It has produced many stalwarts in the field of horticulture and still continuing with its mandate of producing trained manpower for the country. Initially there are **Six Major Departments of Horticultural Sciences** (1. Fruit Science 2. Vegetable Science 3. Floriculture and Landscaping 4. Spice and Plantation Crops

5. Medicinal and Aromatic Plants 6. Post harvest Technology), **Ten supporting Departments** (1. Plant Breeding and Genetics 2. Agronomy 3. Entomology 4. Plant Pathology 5. Soil Science 6. Nematology/ Microbiology 7. Extension Education 8. Agriculture Economics 9. Agriculture Engineering 10. Post Harvest Technology) and **six basic Science departments** [1. Physics and Meteorology 2. Biochemistry and Food Science 3. Bio-technology 4. Botany and Plant Physiology 5. Computer and Statistics 6. Language (English and Hindi)], in the College.

### **Admission Programme**

#### **Under Graduate Admission Procedure**

Admission to UG degree programme is through entrance test (PAT) conducted by Professional Examination Board, Bhopal. The under graduate admission for free seats are given as per PAT merit list. Payment seats are 20% of intake capacity and NRI/Foreign National (5%) are admitted as per State Government approval. In addition to this, 15% seats are filled through ICAR all India entrance examination performance. Fifty per cent of seats are reserved for various reserve categories of candidates. The benefit of reservation to candidates of different categories (SC- 15%, ST- 21% and OBC-14%) is given at UG and P.G. level as per State Government Policy.

## ONLINE COUNSELING PROCESS

### ऑनलाईन काउंसलिंग प्रक्रिया

PAT [B.Sc. (Ag. /Hort./Forestry) and B.Tech. (Agril.Engg.)]

पी.ए.टी (बी.एस.सी (कृषि), बी.एस.सी (उद्यानिकी), बी.एस.सी (वानिकी) एवं बी.टेक (कृषि अभियांत्रिकी))

मध्यप्रदेश में स्थित दोनों कृषि विश्वविद्यालयों, जवाहरलाल नेहरू कृषि विश्वविद्यालय, जबलपुर एवं राजमाता विजयाराजे सिंधिया कृषि विश्वविद्यालय, ग्वालियर के अंतर्गत महाविद्यालयों में बी.एस.सी (कृषि), बी.एस.सी (उद्यानिकी), बी.एस.सी (वानिकी) एवं बी.टेक (कृषि अभियांत्रिकी) पाठ्यक्रमों में प्रवेश देने हेतु ऑनलाईन सयुक्त काउंसलिंग प्रक्रिया बारी-बारी से सम्पन्न करायी जाती है। ऑनलाईन काउंसलिंग हेतु प्रमुख छः चरण होते हैं।

- 1- ऑनलाईन पंजीयन (Online Registration)
- 2- ऑनलाईन प्राथमिकताक्रम का चयन एवं आनलाइन आवेदन/पोर्टल शुल्क का भुगतान (Online preferences/choice filling and payment of online application/portal fee)
- 3- दस्तावेजों का सत्यापन (Documents Verification)
- 4- ऑनलाईन आवंटन (Online Allotment)
- 5- ऑनलाईन आंशिक शिक्षण/काउंसलिंग शुल्क का भुगतान (Online part payment of counseling fee)
- 6- आवंटित संस्था में उपस्थिति एवं प्रवेश (Attendance and Admission in allotted college)

**काउंसलिंग में अर्हकारी परीक्षा में प्राप्ताकों के आधार पर सम्मिलित होने वाले समस्त श्रेणी के अभ्यर्थियों को उपरोक्त सभी चरण 1 से 6 तक का पालन करना होगा।**

#### **1- ऑनलाईन पंजीयन (Online Registration)A**

समस्त श्रेणी के अभ्यर्थियों को काउंसलिंग में सम्मिलित होने के लिये ऑनलाईन पंजीयन कराना होगा। ऑनलाईन काउंसलिंग में सम्मिलित होने के लिये सभी अभ्यर्थी वेबसाइट पर ऑनलाईन पंजीयन करवाएंगे। पंजीयन हेतु कोई शुल्क देय नहीं है। ऑनलाईन काउंसलिंग हेतु अभ्यर्थी इन्टरनेट के माध्यम से प्रदेश में कहीं से भी सम्मिलित हो सकते हैं।

सहायता केंद्र अभ्यर्थियों को Eligible/Not Eligible की पावती जारी करेंगे।

Not Eligible अभ्यर्थी सत्यापन की अंतिम तिथि के पूर्व पुनः उपस्थित होकर अपने सही/चाहे गये दस्तावेजों का सत्यापन करवा सकते हैं अथवा आरक्षित श्रेणी में होने पर अभ्यर्थी अपनी स्वेच्छा से अनारक्षित अभ्यर्थी की श्रेणी में छवज म्सपहपइसम काउंसलिंग हेतु सम्मिलित हो सकेगा।

### 4- ऑनलाईन आवंटन (Online Allotment)

पीएटी में प्राप्तांकों, अभ्यर्थियों द्वारा भरी गई प्राथमिकताक्रम, पीएटी के प्रवेश नियमों के आधार पर कामेंन मेरिट के अनुसार निर्धारित समय सारणी के अनुसार आवंटन किया जावेगा तथा आवंटित संस्था/पाठ्यक्रम का उल्लेख आवंटन पत्र में होगा। जिसे वे अपने लॉग-ईन आईडी/पासवर्ड डालकर इसका प्रिंटआउट प्राप्त करेंगे।

### 5. ऑनलाईन आंशिक शिक्षण/काउंसलिंग [जुल्क का भुगतान (Online part payment of counseling fee)].

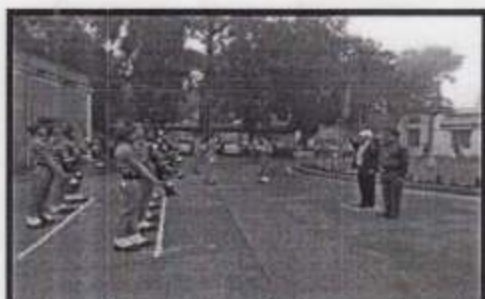

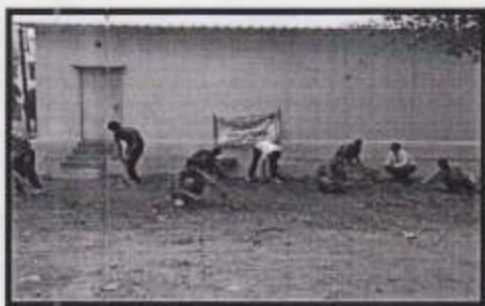

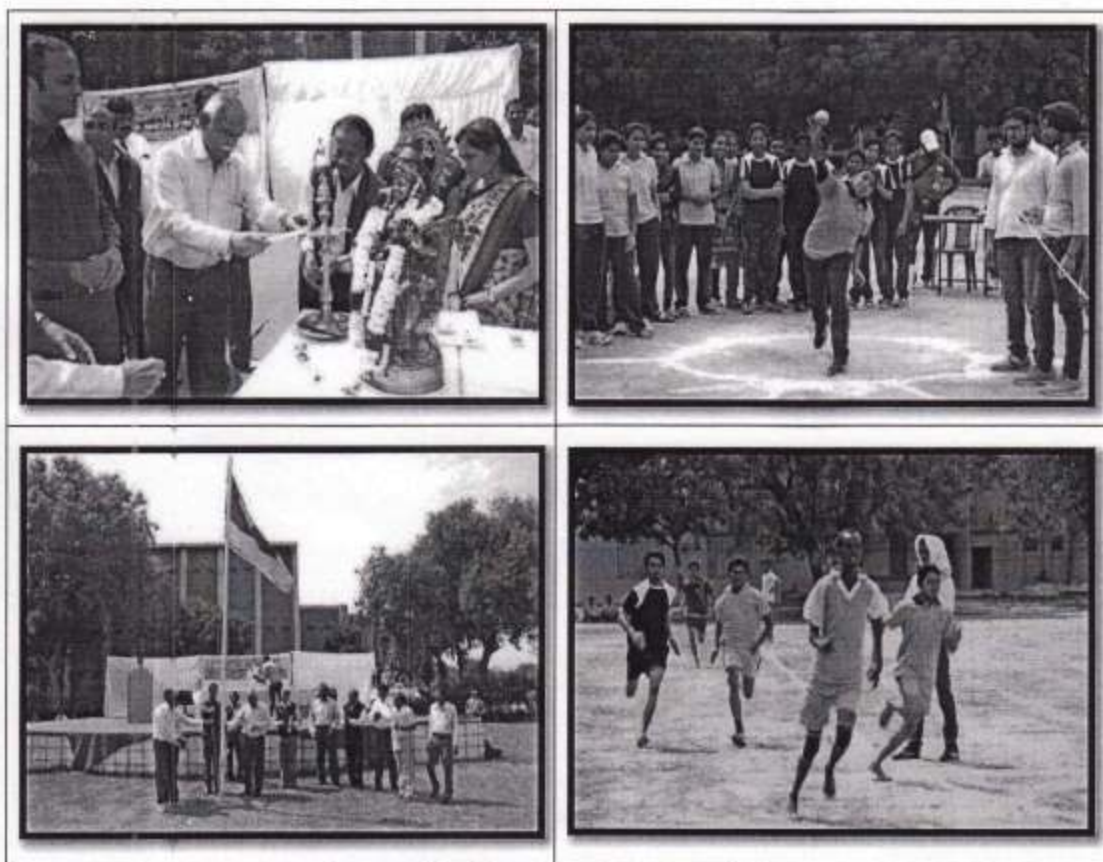


### Sports activities:

## **Educational structure**

The quality education is the top most priority with main thrust on improving the infrastructure and teaching capabilities of the faculty. The ongoing courses of B.Sc. (Agriculture) & B.Sc. (Horticulture) have been restructured as per IV<sup>th</sup> Dean's Committee Recommendation of ICAR.

The Education for all the programmes is through Semester system with 10 point scale for evaluation. The Academic council of the university is responsible for review and modification of the curriculum and syllabi periodically. Apart from theory and practical courses some innovative programmes are also introduced to expose the students to the real farming and farmers conditions, viz. Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWEx) and Rural Horticultural Work Experience (RHWE). Fourth Dean's Committee also introduced Experiential Learning/ Hands on Training programmes for U.G. students for providing adequate confidence and entrepreneurial skills to start vocation. The courses on Experiential Learning / Hands on Training programmes are also introduced in all the College of Agriculture & College of Horticulture at UG level.

All the colleges of Agriculture and college of Horticulture are equipped with adequate facilities to carry out teaching and research.

### **Centre of Advanced Studies**

Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR) New Delhi has recognized the Department of Soil Science and Agril. Chemistry, College of Agriculture, Gwalior as a Centre of Advanced Studies in Soil Science and Agril. Chemistry. The centre is engaged in organizing various training programmes in which Scientists/Teachers and other research workers from different states participate and update their knowledge and skill, in all these training programmes besides RVSKVV trainers, eminent scientists, resource persons from other universities and subject matter specialist from their field of specialization are invited to deliver lectures.
