OTHER CONDITIONS FOR APPLICATION FOR CONTRACTUAL/RETIRED TEACHER

- The post / vacancies are purely temporary and will be filled on contractual basis for I*
 Semester 2023-24.
- Contractual/retired teacher should be engaged on agreement basis provided he/she had minimum qualifications for the post of Assistant Professor for the respective Subject/Post.
- The age limit should not exceed 70 years. Their services will be hired on agreement basis in each semester. However, the agreement can be renew after the end of the semester and agreement can be terminate at any time without pre-notice. (preference may be given for fresh candidate)
- The teacher so engaged should not be on regular roll of pay in any Government Institutions or Institutions aided by the Government of M.P./India.
- The remuneration/honorarium to teachers so appointed should not exceed to Rs. 35000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only) per month. However, for those who registered for Ph.D. before 2009 but completed their degrees after 2009 and those who completed their Ph.D. before 2009 without course work must have two full length research papers in Journals having NAAS rating of 4 or above, the NET shall not be essential. For NAAS rating the rating for the year of publication in question shall be considered.
